Sole source to Native 8(a) firms

- Exempt from \$4M project cap
- Awards cannot be protested
 - No Protest of Native 8(a) Sole Source
 - 13 C.F.R. 124.517 (a)
- See relevant FAR references
- No Dollar Threshold on Sole Source Awards
 - 13 C.F.R. 124.506 (b)
 - Note: J&A required for sole source over \$100M

NHO Contract

- Customer has the ability to tailor the team to efficiently meet requirements
- Contracting process allows the parties to negotiate the Statement of Work and the cost resulting in clear expectations between the parties at a highly competitive price
- Unlike the standard 8(a) contract, the NHO contract vehicle is not limited as to the dollar value of the contract
- A directed contract to a NHO may not be appealed
